How much?

- RM 350
- Note: Officer/Pastor's Children to have 50% discount on fees
- Do approach Captain Vincent should you face difficulties meeting the camp fees

What's included?

- Transportation (to and fro)
- Accommodation and Camp facilities
- Food (3B 4L 3D 3S)
- Camp Activities



Activities to look forward to:

- White Water Rafting @ Sg Kampar
- Adventure Caving @ Gua Tempurung
- DIY Meals



How will the Meals be provided?

- Meals will be prepared by the members themselves
- Members will be split into 4 people per cooking squads
- Each squads is supposed to prepare 7 meals (3B 1L 3D)
- A budget of RM 100 will be allocated to each squads
- Receipt of purchase must be kept in order to claim
- Cooking squads will be announced on 12th August in the bb2sj.org website
- The other 3L will not be prepared by members



Accommodation & Facilities

- Members will be sleeping in tents (4D 3N)
- Members taking Camping Advanced Award will be sleeping in tarp tents
- Access to toilet, electricity etc.

Days Before Camp	7	6	5	4	3	2	1	Camp
Do Self-Test 1 day before Camp							Negative	Ok
If positive up to 5 days before Camp							Negative	Ok
If Close Contact up to 5 days before Camp							Negative	Ok
If positive/close contact up to 4 days before Camp								No

- A negative self test on Wednesday night (before going to FBC on Day 1)
- Camp members will be sleeping in tents, hence smaller space. Preventive measures such as Covid-19 testing prior to camp are crucial to avoid transmission
- If a camp participant cannot attend due to Covid/Sickness, refund will be issued (please refer to REFUND POLICY for more info)



COVID-19 SOP - Emergency Evacuation

- If any members develop COVID symptoms during camp, self-test will be performed
- Close contact members will be ask to perform self-test
- If self-test is positive and it is Day 1/2/3 members will quarantined
- Parent(s)/Guardian(s) will be informed to pick up member from the campsite**

- Members are NOT allowed to jump straight to Advanced Level awards



Packing List

What to Bring:

- Sufficient clothes (4D 3N)
- Sweater, Track Pants, Long Pants (It will be cold at night)
- Sport shoes, Slippers, Socks (Shoes will get wet)
- **Adidas Kampung** (optional but recommended)**
- Raincoat
- Sun hat/Cap
- Sleeping bag
- **Aluminium Foam Insulation Mat** (compulsory)**
- Torch Light, Spare batteries
- Toiletries, Towel, Hanger
- Medication (if required)
- Plastic bags (for dirty laundry)
- Insect repellent
- Mess tins, Utensils
- Bible
- **Sufficient food****
- Copy of Identification Card

What NOT to bring:

- Trolley bag
- Uniform parts
- Board games
- Poker card

Note:

- All items will need to be packed neatly as you will be carrying your belongings to the campsite
- Gadgets, electronics, mobile phones are NOT prohibited but we will not be responsible for your items
- Light-coloured clothing are NOT encouraged
- Shorts are allowed but NOT shorter than 3 fingers above the knee

2. ADIDAS KAMPUNG

- Rubber shoes ideal for trekking/water activities
- Optional

- Water proof, insulated mat
- Compulsory
